A Reflection from Fr. Jay – The Holy Eucharist and the Saints

Mark your calendars, St. Helen Parish will host Patrick O'Hearn for two talks on Palm Sunday, March 24th.

Patrick O'Hearn is a husband and father of two children on earth and two children in Heaven. He grew up in the Midwest, primarily in Illinois and Ohio. His parents are from Ohio and live in Concord Township. He resides outside of Charlotte, North Carolina. He obtained his undergraduate degree in marketing from St. Ambrose University and his master's in education from Franciscan University.

He has authored or coauthored seven books and counting. He was a contributor to Fr. Donald Calloway's latest release: 30-Day Eucharistic Revival. He was blessed to work with St. Helen's parishioner, Sue McIlroy, on his book Nursery of Heaven. Patrick's latest book is Our Lady of Sorrows: Devotion to Mary's Seven Sorrows for Children by Sophia Institute Press.

Patrick served as TAN Books Senior Acquisitions editor for over two years. He currently works as a content writer for Fuzati, a Catholic Marketing Firm as well as a freelance editor.

This September, Patrick will be leading a pilgrimage to Ireland with St. Charles Pilgrimages accompanied by Fr. Brendan Hankins, a Norbertine Priest from St. Michael's Abbey in California.


