SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT FEBRUARY 25, 2024

A Reflection from James Hogan - What to Add This Lent

Lent is the time when we give up some good treat or bad habit. But it is also a time to add the virtue of piety. After all, fasting and abstaining without piety is just dieting! Piety is a subset of the virtue of justice, giving to God what is due Him, and what is due Him is everything. As our relationship with God deepens, the more we see Him in others. Obeying His commandments becomes more a desire and less an obligation. And just as communication is at the heart of a strong friendship, prayer is at the heart of a pious friendship with the Lord.

"Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God." (CCC 2559) Prayer is the heart moving to higher ground, to holy ground. Prayer attaches us to what is God's and detaches us from what is not. Prayer is our response to God first communicating with us. Prayer is collaboration with God, to co-labor, to work for and with Him.

Prayer can be illuminated by contrasts: Prayer is not knowing about God; it is knowing God. Prayer is not talking at God; it is talking to God. Prayer is not finding time for God; it is making time with God. Prayer is not just talking to God; it is also listening to God. Prayer is not about making us feel better before God; it is about making us better before God.

Therese of Lisieux noted, "Prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and love, embracing both trial and joy." Just as our heart has longed to encounter God, God has been yearning for us to encounter Him so that He might make us more like Himself.

There are four basic phrases that lie at the heart of any good relationship: *I love you*. Adoration is acting on the First Commandment: love God with your whole heart. Adoration is "man acknowledging that he is a creature before his Creator." (CCC 2628) Peter Kreeft wrote, "Adoration is love unlimited, love-squared, love raised to infinity by the exponent of love itself."

I'm sorry. Words of contrition reveal the side of ourselves we do not like to recognize, yet it is a "prerequisite for righteous and pure prayer." (CCC 2631) Admitting sin reveals the truth about ourselves. And if we live truthfully, we can relate to God more honestly. He can then forgive and bless us all the more.

Please. Words of petition disclose to God what our needs and desires are, which is necessary in any real friendship. Jesus encouraged us to petition God, "give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our trespasses." Petitions are then followed by watching and waiting for God to respond in His own way. We petition God for what we want; He grants what we need. Thank you. Words of thanksgiving remind us that all gifts flow from the Gift-giver. The more thanks that are expressed, the more an attitude of gratitude is returned. Free of expectations, grateful people are happy people. G.K. Chesterton reflected, "I would maintain that thanks are the highest form of thought; and that gratitude is happiness doubled by wonder." So, this Lent, add more piety, eat less pie.


